sion on child labour and the importance of education.

The Madras High Court in collaboration with NGO's associated with Childline organized a rally on "Protection Against Child Labour" on 27th June, 2016. Some children from our shelter homes were active participants of the rally in which Honorable Judges, lawyers, Studens and Social Activists created awareness on the theme 'Every Child in meant to learn and not to earn'.



Rally Against Child Labor @ Marina Beach

On the 18th of June, DBAI & CHILDLINE (1098) in association with Don Bosco Beatitudes, Marivalava, Anbagam & ICPS/NCLP Centre children organized a mass awareness rally voicing Against Child Labor from Labor statue in Marina Beach to Light house. More than 300 children participated actively in the rally which was flagged off by Mr. Siva Jai Kumar (District Child Protection Officer, Chennai). In a short cultural programme that followed the rally in St. Bede's Campus, Actor and Director Mr. Samuthirakani, the chief guest of the event motivated the boys to stand for their rights come what may. In the end all the participants pledged their oath against Child Labour.



Healing of the Inner Child

On the 4th and 5th of June, the shelter home girls in Sarnalaya, Kodungayur had two intensive days of Individual and group therapy on the theme "Healing of the Inner Child."

Mr. J. A Nathan the resource person who has experience in counseling people in private sectors facilitated this experience for our children. Journal writing, drawing, color personality test, self evaluation test, motivational videos and healing prayers were used as means to help them understand, accept and heal themselves of their past hurts. Healed of their inner hurts in the two days workshop the children were high in spirits to begin a new again.





Vocational Guidance - Government Home Children at Royapuram.

Fr. Leo offered Vocational Training Guidance to Reception centre and railway children at Royapuram on 29^{th} of June. 30 children participated along with their parents. Tips were given to the children mainly on six different technical and job oriented training programmes. Following him Dr. Manorama, CHES Director, also spoke about importance of Vocational skill training.



Success Story

In a joint operation, the Childline team in collaboration with Child Labor Department and National Child Labor Project rescued 5 minors from Bihar who were found to be working in a Bag Production unit in Broadway, Chennai. The rescued children were examined in the Government Dental Hospital College and were confirmed to be between 13-16 years of age. They were produced before the CWC (Child Welfare Committee) and are given shelter and care in DBAI. Measures are being taken to rehabilitate them with their families in Bihar.

Vocational Training - Certificate distribution
