I love watching children play especially when they invent their own imaginative mystical and creative games. They're so excited, energetic and engaged as they build their muscles along with their imagination and confidence. And it's so much more enjoyable for children than parking them in front of the TV.

In my mission with the young children who are abandoned and are deprived of their childhood, I've watched always hundreds of children learn new skills of life and enjoy the pure act of physical play. The Philosophy of Physique is "A Sound mind in a Sound body". Does that phrase sound familiar? Yes, of course. If the body is healthy, the mind is healthy too. No wonder the greatest Tamil philosopher and altruist Vallalar makes his famous statement as follows:

_"உடம்பை வளர்த்தேன் உயிர் வளர்<u>த்</u>தேனே!"

Which means by nurturing my body, I nurture my spirit.

Every aspect of Human development is possible only through physical development. That's the reason, Don Bosco in his pedagogy of teaching, emphasized Run, Jump and Play as essential part of his education system.

Children will develop and learn about co-ordination, balance, spatial relationship, fine-motor skills and improve muscular strength, endurance, flexibility and body composition.

Through physical activity, children try new things, conquer their fears and build their confidence. It has been proven that when children are physically. Active and successful in their movements, they show higher levels of self-esteem.

But today, we have a crisis and we are running out of time. Our schools and educational system run in deficit not financially but in unstructured play and outdoor activities. Stats are revealing the painful reality that an average, children are spending 7.5 hours in front of media devices everyday.

Children will not learn relational skills. Children will not learn to solve problems. Children will not know how to manage emotions. Our children are playing less than any other generation. It doesn't matter if they win or lose— its about staying together and playing together. Let's make our children play and let's preserve their identity.

World Day Against Child Labour



According to ILO's data, hundreds of millions of girls and boys throughout the world are involved in work that deprives them of receiving an
adequate education, health, leisure and basic freedom, violating this
way their rights. Of these children, more than half are exposed to the
worst forms of child labour. These worst forms of child labour include
work in hazardous environments, slavery, or other forms of forced labour, illicit activities such as drug trafficking and prostitution, as well
as involvement in armed conflict.

To speed-up the eradication process of child labour, DBAI-CHILDLINE 1098 has conducted events (Rally, Human Chain, Signature Campaign & Role plays) to create awareness to the public in Chennai, TamilNadu. The main objective of the event is To Bring the support in one umbrella to raise voice in sound. towards the cause.

The event was conducted on 14th June 2018 at Directorate of social defense, between 3-5pm. It was headed by Mr. Lalvena IAS, Commissioner of Social Defense, TN. Mr. Dhanasekara Pandiyan, Jt. Director., Mrs. Uma Maheswari, Superintendent., Mrs. Ponnarasi from Social defense and CWC Members of Chennai also supported in-person being present in the event.

The programme started with the Cultural events along with other Organizations from Mariyalaya, Govt. home for Girls and our boys from Bosco Illam followed by signature campaign beginning with Mr. Lalvena IAS, Rally flagged-off with Mr. Dhanasekara Pandiyan, Human Chain with


