
FEAST OF THE FOUNDER

STAFF CAPACITY BUILDING

The main issues that came out were School Dropouts, Educational Help and Substance abuse. A visibility painting about Childline was also inaugurated by the Chief Guest during the program.

Open House for the month of February was planned and conducted at Cindhadripet Police Boys' and Girls' Club on 22nd February, 2020. The Chief Guests for the event were Mr. Shanmugam, Sub Inspector of Police-F1 Police Station, Cindhatripet, Mr. Ambrose, Health Inspector of Zone 5, Greater Chennai Corporation and Mr. Vijayan, Coordinator of Advaita Bhakta Sabha. The Chief Guests were invited based on the issues that was said by the community people which are High rate of School Dropouts, Usage of Substances and Health & Hygiene Problems due to lack of Public Toilet.
