Our organization extends its reach through various community centers, offering support and intervention to children in underserved areas. DISTRICT LEVEL INSPECTION COMMITTEE (DLIC) VISIT



MIRACLE FOUNDATION MEETING IN CCI

On 19th of December 2024, Mr. Benin from Miracle Foundation and Mr. Daniel from the District Child Protection Unit (DCPU) visited the Child Care Institution (CCI) to discuss family reintegration plans and assess the activities undertaken at the CCI. During the discussion, Mr. Benin emphasized the importance of reintegrating children with their families, wherever feasible, and aligning with child welfare principles.

After the assessment, a brief report highlighting potentials and areas of improvement was submitted to the management for next level proceedings.



TRAINING ON CHILD CARE

On 26th November 2024, Guardians of Dreams Foundation conducted training for staff members in Saranalayam on integrated child care. Ms. Abilasha lyer and Ms. Dipika from Guardians of dreams along with Ms. Caroline and Ms. Oliva from TARA Foundation jointly conducted this workshop in a very interactive manner. Workshop included topics such as cultivating team work, leadership qualities and addressing the need of children. The day's sessions were highly active and sound. A lot of fun games and puzzles were also conducted by resource persons.



SESSION ON BALANCING EMOTIONS

On 27th November 2024, Ms. Reyan Deepshi, Child Welfare Officer conducted a session on Emotional Intelligence for 15 to 17 years children. This event was aimed to help children understand the importance of teen age emotional stability, focusing on goals and personal development. Participants were made to engage in short activities that set the stage for open learning. Real-life scenarios were shared to illustrate common challenges and solutions. The session included an inspiring talk on importance of self-discipline and resilience in achieving goals and how emotional stability can positively influence academic performance and relationships. A sense of camaraderie and mutual encouragement was fostered among the group.



ART THERAPY




PARTICIPATION IN NCC CAMP


EDUCATIONAL WINTER CAMP 2024


Joy of gathering


